

## **Text Messages: Policy of Baltinglass Golf Club**

All members, if they so wish, may receive text message information re normal club activities. The text service is generally to inform members of up-coming club events particularly weekly competitions, club social events, interclub matches, general meetings of the Club, bereavements related to a Club member and so forth. To receive this service, members must submit their mobile number to Baltinglass Golf Club as required. At all times, members are free to cancel this service.

As a general rule, a text message will not be immediately sent to members on the death of a fellow member or former member of the Club, as the club will not be the bearer of such information in advance of family members being informed. On other occasions, the Club may be unaware of the death of a person until after the funeral date. A text message will be sent by the Club only when it becomes aware of the death of a member, former member, as well as a parent/guardian, spouse/partner, brother, sister, son & daughter of a member. When the text relates to a bereavement, one will be directed to rip.ie re the details of the funeral arrangements. As a general rule, the Club will not send text messages to Club members on the death of other extended family members. However, the Executive Committee reserve the right to send text messages on certain occasions when it decides that it is appropriate to do so.

On certain occasions, text messages will be sent solely to committee members to inform them of meetings, events where representation of members is sought and so forth.

On receipt of details, the Club will make every effort to avoid relaying any misinformation to its members. However, in the event of an error being made, the Club will endeavour to correct this at the earliest possible moment.
